HENNA & TINTING PRE & POST INSTRUCTIONS:

- If possible, remove makeup before attending your appointment.

- Remove contact lenses before a lash tint.

- If you have had a Henna brow treatment within the last three months, you will be unable to have a regular tint; Henna coats the hair, leaving regular tint unable to penetrate it.

- Never open your eyes during a tinting procedure. This may cause temporary or permanent irritation or damage to your eyes.

- Dependent on your skin type, there is no guarantee that the tint/Henna will stain your skin, or how long the tint/Henna will remain on your skin/hair.

- Dependent on your skin type, Henna can have a drying effect on your skin.

- Henna will not last as long on oily skin, but will improve with continued use of Henna.

- Henna and tint will not adhere as well, if at all, to scar tissue.

- Wearing mascara (after a lash tint) may reduce the longevity of the tint.

- Do not use oil based makeup remover as this will reduce the longevity of

your tint/Henna and may even remove the tint/Henna all together.

- Do not use fake tan for at least 24 hours, as this will turn the tint/Henna green.

- Do not get the tint/Henna wet for 24 hours.

- If you wear sunscreen, use a physical barrier type like zinc cream or titanium dioxide, as chemical sunscreens accelerate Henna fading.

- Chlorine and salt water will fade the Henna faster than usual.
